**HF0045 - Chief Author:** Bigham

**Description:** Penalty provided for careless driving resulting in death, and providing for revocation of violator's driver's license.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** This is the 2nd "2010 Session TRACKER" report edited as of 2/27/10 Cal Saari

**HF0251 - Chief Author:** Benson

**Description:** Teri Lee Law specification designated.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** This bill was referred to the Crime Victims Committee where it has yet to be considered. SF 0083 also sits w/o action. Lack of progress is somewhat of a surprise in view of the publicity there was which prompted this proposal.

**HF0292 - Chief Author:** Rukavina

**Description:** Medical marijuana use provided, civil and criminal penalties provided, expiration date provided for medical use of marijuana provisions, and money appropriated.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** This bill and the SF 0292 moved thru the legislature last Session, but was vetoed by the Governor in late May, 2009. I'm leaving on the tracker as it can be expected to come up again in the 2010 Session.

**HF0317 - Chief Author:** Nornes

**Description:** Adult certification for juveniles age lowered, and violent juvenile offense defined.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** This was a hot topic early in the last Session, but we joined several other groups to oppose this bill and it was dropped from further discussion. It is believed this may resurface in the 2010 Session so we'll continue to track it for the time being.

**HF0449 - Chief Author:** Mullery

**Description:** Crisis intervention team grants established, and money appropriated.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** This bill was passed by a couple of House committees in the 2009 Session but is an appropriation bill and I doubt it has a chance to move this year, but we'll continue to track thru March to see if there's a desire to move it forward by legislators.

**HF0497 - Chief Author:** Mullery

**Description:** Firearm data access authorized by parole and probation authorities.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Rep. Mullery authored this bill at our request. It was in the final language of the Data Practices Omnibus bill in 2009 but was never enacted. This bill will be heard in Mullery's Civil Justice Committee on Feb 8th and is expected to be ok'ed and placed on the General Register. This will allow it to be considered in this year's Omnibus bill.[House General Register](#)

**HF0800 - Chief Author:** Cornish

**Description:** Use of force in defense of home and person law clarified, Minnesota's self-defense and defense of home laws codified and extended, common law eliminated, boundaries of dwelling expanded, presumption created, and rights available extended to a person defending against entry of occupied vehicle.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** This bill got a lot of attention in the last session. It has a companion bill introduced in the Senate, SF 0893. Neither bill moved in last year's Session - we'll watch to see if Rep. Cornish revives this proposal.

**HF0891 - Chief Author:** Champion

**Description:** Expungement law expanded and modified, courts authorized to modify or suspend collateral sanctions under certain circumstances, and situations limited in which juvenile delinquency criminal record is publicly available.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** The companion bill, SF 0560, passed thru a few committees last year without final action. We'll watch what comes up this Session. Sen. Moua has introduced SF 2790 this Session which also deals with expungement so you can expect that one to move forward.

**HF1087 - Chief Author:** Hilstrom

**Description:** Preadjudication detention of certain children prohibited, risk assessment instrument required to assist in preadjudication detention release decisions, community-based noncustodial supervision options required for children released from preadjudication detention, and money appropriated.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Juvenile Justice folks should watch this closely. Senator Moua conducted a hearing on this issue on Jan 25, 2010, and it appears she has decided to do some more work with various groups on this instead of moving forward with legislation at this time.

**HF1962 - Chief Author:** Kohls

**Description:** Juvenile petty offender parents allowed probation supervisory duties, and children's mental health screening duties changed.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** HF 1962 /SF 1768 did not really catch on for movement in 2009, but perhaps should be watched to see if a committee decides to give further hearings.

**HF2027 - Chief Author:** Johnson

**Description:** Probation officers and pretrial release agents authorized to conduct searches of persons on probation or pretrial release.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** This bill was introduced by Rep Johnson at the request of MACPO. Rep Mullery proposes a different approach and as chair of the Civil Justice committee, this bill must pass thru his committee. I will attempt to schedule a meeting with Rep Mullery and the MACPO rep's to see if a compromise is possible.

**HF2143 - Chief Author:** Westrom

**Description:** Sex offenders required to wear tracking and monitoring bracelets after release from prison, penalties prescribed, and money appropriated.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** No action taken.

**HF2607 - Chief Author:** Mullery

**Description:** Detention placement options clarified for extended jurisdiction juveniles pending revocation hearings.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Since this proposal is included in our legislative agenda, we testified before the House Policy and Oversight Committee on 2/22 where the bill was passed in Committee and placed on the General Register. There is no mention in this bill to address a rural exception and it was reported that the DOC has agreed to work with Rep Mullery to address that in this bill. [House General Register](#)

**HF2618 - Chief Author:** Mullery

**Description:** Court required to provide a general notice of collateral sanctions to a juvenile before accepting a guilty plea.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Another Mullery proposal which has support from several organizations so I'd expect him to move this along in his Civil Justice Committee. I also testified on this bill on 2/22 where it was passed and referred to the Public Safety Finance Committee.

**HF2619 - Chief Author:** Mullery

**Description:** Admissibility of a child's statements made during a mental health examination prohibited on the issue of guilt.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** A Mullery proposal that we sought our input on prior to introduction. It has been referred to Hilstrom's Policy and Oversight Committee where we'll watch for a hearing date.

**HF2665 - Chief Author:** Mullery

**Description:** Discharge plans required for juvenile offenders who have mental or emotional problems, and money appropriated.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):**

**HF2691 - Chief Author:** Hilstrom

**Description:** State and local jail and prison inmates required to be housed in publicly owned and operated jails and prisons; state and counties prohibited from contracting with private prisons; and Prairie Correctional Facility contract renewal prohibited.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** An interesting proposal introduced by Rep. Hilstrom, and she has several authors for SF 2478 on the Senate side. SF 2876 relates to this and is being introduced in the Senate on 3/01.

**HF2707 - Chief Author:** Mullery

**Description:** Juvenile delinquency continuance period duration extended.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** This is an interesting proposal, and I hear some reservations about this, but we'll be looking for further details on the support and/or opposition to this.

**HF2819 - Chief Author:** Mullery

**Description:** Public access to certain juvenile records modified and release of records limited.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** This bill was introduced by Rep Mullery this week (2/8) and has been a discussion item in the Juvenile Justice Coalition meetings in which Rep Mullery has been quite active. We'll report on the 3/01 committee hearing on this bill in our next report.

**HF2864 - Chief Author:** Gardner

**Description:** Pilot project authorized to allow judges to order electronic monitoring for domestic abuse offenders on pretrial release.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** the House bill HF 2864, is moving thru committee but there has not been a hearing to date on the Senate companion. [House Committee Report](#)

**HF2952 - Chief Author:** Murphy, M.

**Description:** State employees retirement plan contribution rates increased, interest rates on refunds and certain benefit accrual rates reduced, vesting requirements and early retirement reduction rates increased, and certain amortization periods extended.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** This bill is one of several bills introduced by the Pension Commission to deal with the anticipated funding deficiencies in the pension plans. Some of these bills had an initial hearing on 2/26 without action being taken but this is very likely to pass this year in some form. I'll try to provide a full profile on the Pension Commission's plan in future legislative update report.

**HF2965 - Chief Author:** Paymar

**Description:** Gang and drug task forces certification process established, criminal gang investigative data systems creation authority established, certain entities dissolved, and forfeiture reporting requirements amended.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):**

**HF2979 - Chief Author:** Rosenthal

**Description:** Alcohol concentration lowered from 0.20 to 0.16 for an aggravating factor under DWI law.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** As you can see, this proposal is being heard on 3/2/10 before the Policy and Oversight Committee.

**HF2999 - Chief Author:** Murphy, M.

**Description:** Public Employees Retirement Association plan provisions amended, terms defined, contribution and interest rates adjusted, vesting requirements modified, postretirement adjustments provided, and privatized hospital employee election eliminated.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Another pension related bill that I'll have more info on in a future update report.

**HF3081 - Chief Author:** Hilstrom

**Description:** Criminal sexual conduct in the first degree penalty increased.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** This bill could be tied to the result of the bonding dispute between the Governor and the House and Senate, depending on what is finally agreed upon on the \$89 Million for Moose Lake.

**HF3106 - Chief Author:** Bigham

**Description:** Implied consent, driving while impaired, and ignition interlock provisions modified.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Scheduled for hearing in the Policy and Oversight Committee on 3/2/10 and no action to date on the Senate companion bill, SF 2741.

**HF3174 - Chief Author:** Bigham

**Description:** Predatory offender registration law amended to address registrants living in homeless shelters and to clarify that the registration requirement for offenders who move out of state are suspended not terminated.

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Recently introduced and has not yet received a hearing.

**SF0083 - Chief Author:** Bonoff

**Description:** Teri Lee Law designation

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** This bill is an effort to require a photograph being attached to Orders for Protection and No Contact orders, but has yet to get an actual hearing in either chamber.

**SF0097 - Chief Author:** Murphy

**Description:** Medical use of marijuana

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Check comment on HF 292. Passed last year but vetoed by the Governor - don't if they'll try to bring it forward again in 2010.

**SF0256 - Chief Author:** Skogen

**Description:** Juvenile adult certification age reduction

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Check comment on HF 317. I really haven't heard anything to date, of an effort will be made to revive this. It must be passed by a committee in mid-March if they hope to bring this forward.

**SF0318 - Chief Author:** Foley

**Description:** Crisis intervention team (CIT) grants

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Check comment on HF 449.

**SF0765 - Chief Author:** Moua

**Description:** Juvenile delinquency and justice provisions modifications; juvenile detention risk assessment instrument adoption requirement

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Refer to comment on HF 1087. I don't believe this will move forward this year, but we'll monitor for a few weeks.

**SF0893 - Chief Author:** Pariseau

**Description:** Deadly force use in self defense

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** There appeared to be a lot of interest in this bill and it's companion, HF 0800, but neither seems to be moving forward at this time.

**SF0992 - Chief Author:** Moua

**Description:** Firearms data access by parole and probation authorities

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Since the Senate passed this provision last year, it does not need to revive this, and the language is similar to HF 497 so we hope to see this in the Data Practices Omnibus bill this year.

**SF1228 - Chief Author:** Dille

**Description:** Minors consensual sexual relationship stay of adjudication, predatory offender registration exemption and sex education program criminal sexual conduct laws requirement

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** This has been referred to the Judiciary Committee but has not been heard.

**SF1231 - Chief Author:** Latz

**Description:** Criminal records expungements laws recodification and restructuring and eligibility expansion

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** This Senate bill is one of several "Second Chance" proposals but has yet to be heard.

**SF1265 - Chief Author:** Higgins

**Description:** Ex-criminal offender reentry employment services pilot project and appropriation

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):**

**SF1412 - Chief Author:** Ingebrigtsen

**Description:** Sex offender tracking and monitoring bracelet use requirement

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):**

**SF1451 - Chief Author:** Latz

**Description:** Pretrial diversion programs establishment for all counties

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** This bill proposed by Sen. Latz, Foley and Mary Olson, would require a pretrial diversion program in every county. It has no companion bill in the House at this point.

**SF1534 - Chief Author:** Tomassoni

**Description:** High-risk adults demonstration project continuation appropriation

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Has not moved in either chamber, probably due to the appropriation needed.

**SF1538 - Chief Author:** Carlson

**Description:** High-risk adults demonstration project grants appropriation

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** No action.

**SF1768 - Chief Author:** Ingebrigtsen

**Description:** Juvenile petty offenders court disposition decisions expansion; children's mental health screening duties modification

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Although the Senate bill has not been heard, the House companion, HF 1962 was heard by the Public Safety Policy and Oversight Committee, passed and sent to Finance. The Finance chair then re-referred the bill to the Public Safety Finance Division.

**SF1806 - Chief Author:** Moua

**Description:** Probation officer and pretrial release agent search authorization

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** No action on the Senate bill but Rep Sheldon Johnson authored HF 2027, which was heard in the Public Safety Policy and Oversight Committee and passed without extensive discussion last Spring. Rep Mullery advocates a different approach and this bill must eventually pass his committee in order to move forward.

**SF2631 - Chief Author:** Betzold

**Description:** Public employees retirement association (PERA) plan terms, contribution rates, vesting requirements and interest rates adjustments modifications; postretirement adjustments; privatized hospital employee election elimination

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** One of several related pension bills heard by the Pension Commission on 2/26, but without further action at this point. I'll be explaining more on the plan to address the anticipated pension deficiencies in a future update report.

**SF2636 - Chief Author:** Wiger

**Description:** Electronic monitoring for domestic abuse offenders pilot project authorization

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** The House bill, HF 2864 has been passed by the Victims/Criminal Records Division and should be heard soon again in the Policy and Oversight Committee. Then expect action on the Senate file.

**SF2725 - Chief Author:** Moua

**Description:** Gang and drug oversight council membership, duties and governing board modifications, criminal gang investigative data systems and multijurisdictional gang and drug strike forces certification process establishment

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Just introduced in the Senate, no hearing to date.

**SF2736 - Chief Author:** Scheid

**Description:** Criminal sexual conduct in the first degree penalty increase

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):**

**SF2741 - Chief Author:** Murphy

**Description:** Driving while impaired (DWI), implied consent and ignition interlock provisions modifications

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Recently introduced, no hearing yet.

**SF2754 - Chief Author:** Latz

**Description:** Child admission of guilt during mental health examinations usage prohibition

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):**

**SF2755 - Chief Author:** Latz

**Description:** Detention placement options clarification for extended jurisdiction juveniles

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** The House bill has passed and if the Senate moves on SF 2755 this language could be included in an Omnibus bill. See HF 2607 for further info.

**Description:** Collateral sanctions notice to juvenile prior to guilty plea acceptance

**Description:** Continuance period duration in juvenile delinquency procedures extension

**Description:** Juvenile records public hearings and access provisions modifications

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):** Introduced this past week - no House companion bill yet.

**SF2862 - Chief Author:** Scheid

**Description:** Predatory offenders registration requirements clarification and modification for moving out of state

**Alerts (if any):**

**Your Notes (if any):**

**SF2876 - Chief Author:** Kubly

**Description:** Minnesota correctional facility - Moose Lake transfer of control from commissioner of corrections to commissioner of human services; bond issue and appropriation

**Your Notes (if any):** This may be tied to the debate on the bonding bill.
